Attachment "B"

Particular Things to be Seized

The items to be seized are evidence, contraband, fruits, or instrumentalities of violations of Title 18, United States Code, 371 (Conspiracy), 18 U.S.C. § 795 (Photographing and Sketching Defense Installations), 18 U.S.C. § 796 (Use of an Aircraft for Photographing Defense Installations), and 18 U.S.C. § 797 (Publication and Sale of Photographs of Defense Installations) (collectively, the "Subject Offenses"), namely:

- 1. Records and information relating to any military installations in the United States.
- 2. Records, materials, and documents relating to the operation of military installations, national defense information, and/or classified or unclassified military programs;
- Records and documents relating to the identity or location of any other known and unknown co-conspirators; and
- Any digital device which is itself or which contains evidence, contraband, fruits,
 or instrumentalities of the Subject Offenses, and forensic copies thereof.
- 5. With respect to any digital device containing evidence falling within the scope of the foregoing categories of items to be seized:
- a. evidence of who used, owned, or controlled the device at the time the things described in this warrant were created, edited, or deleted;
- b. evidence of the presence or absence of software that would allow others to control the device, such as viruses, Trojan horses, and other forms of malicious software, as well as evidence of the presence or absence of security software designed to detect malicious software;
 - c. evidence of the attachment of other devices;
- d. evidence of counter-forensic programs (and associated data) that are designed to eliminate data from the device;

e. evidence of the times the device was used;

f. applications, programs, software, documentation, manuals, passwords, keys, and other access devices that may be necessary to access the device or data stored on the device, to run software contained on the device, or to conduct a forensic examination of the device;

g. records of or information about Internet Protocol addresses used by the device.

h. As used herein, the terms "records," "information," "documents," "programs," "applications," and "materials" include records, information, documents, programs, applications, and materials created, modified, or stored in any form, including in digital form on any digital device and any forensic copies thereof.

i. As used herein, the term "digital device" includes any electronic system or device capable of storing or processing data in digital form, including central processing units; desktop, laptop, notebook, and tablet computers; personal digital assistants; wireless communication devices, such as telephone paging devices, beepers, mobile telephones, and smart phones; digital cameras; gaming consoles (including Sony PlayStations and Microsoft Xboxes); peripheral input/output devices, such as keyboards, printers, scanners, plotters, monitors, and drives intended for removable media; related communications devices, such as modems, routers, cables, and connections; storage media, such as hard disk drives, floppy disks, memory cards, optical disks, and magnetic tapes used to store digital data (excluding analog tapes such as VHS); and security devices.
